Please find below details of the activities our Year 6 pupils will be involved in during the last few weeks of term –

### TUESDAY 27<sup>TH</sup> JUNE - Y6 TRANSITION DAY SPOFFORTH SCHOOL

The Year 6 pupils from nine local village schools will be taking part in this day. The day will involve team building exercises designed so the children can meet and work with children who will be moving on to the same secondary schools as them.

**Children should be dropped off at Spofforth Village Hall between 9.30am and 9.45am. Mrs Honey will be there to meet them and walk them up to the school. They should be picked up from the hall again at 2.40p.m. Children will all need to wear school polo-shirts/sweatshirts, jogging/tracksuit bottoms and trainers and bring a water bottle. A packed lunch will be provided.**

### THURSDAY 6<sup>TH</sup> JULY – CRUCIAL CREW

Every year our Year 6 children attend the Crucial Crew Workshops run by North Yorkshire Police. This year it will be held at the Harrogate College, Hornbeam Park on the morning of Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> July. The workshop scenarios include such things as Road Accidents (St John Ambulance), Gas Safety, Online safety, Electricity Safety, Fire Safety (North Yorkshire Fire & Rescue Service), drugs awareness, etc.. **The children will be transported to/from the college by car and will be back at school in time for a late lunch. If you are able to help with transport or would prefer to drop your child off at the college at 9.40am, please let Miss Boyd know.**

### TUESDAY 18<sup>TH</sup> JULY – YEAR-END PERFORMANCE

The children will be presenting their year- end performance 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> July. There will be two performances, one at 2pm and another at 7pm. Both performances will take place in All Saints Church and all parents are very welcome to attend.
