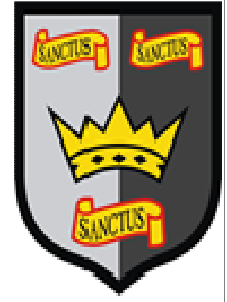

BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL CARE

Due to the ill health of the owner of Otley Kids Club/Kirkby Kids, we have brought the before and after school club under the control of school with immediate effect. The club will be run with the same staff and will continue to run from 7.30am to 8.50am in the mornings and 3.30pm to 6pm every afternoon. The prices will remain the same - £6 from 7.30am with breakfast (£5.50 without breakfast), £7.50 until 5pm and £9.50 until 6pm. Payments can be made through Parentpay (either daily, weekly or monthly) and we are also able to accept childcare vouchers, please let us know if you would like to pay in this way.

As the club is now run by the school all pupils may attend at any time, there is no need to register or complete any forms. Ad-hoc bookings are welcome - there is no need to book for the morning sessions, just come along from 7.30am onwards; and for the afternoon sessions just let us know in the morning or contact the school office on 01423 872491 (it is fine to leave a message on the answerphone) or email admin@kirkbyoverblow.n-yorks.sch.uk . CONSENT FORMS

In your red folders this week are visit consent and data collection forms for all children except for our new starters. Please check the details for your child(ren), sign **both** sides of the form and return to school.

Children in Jupiter Class will also receive rules for responsible internet use and permission forms. Please read through these with your child, sign and return to school. Thank you.

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SCHOOL MEALS

Under the government's 'Universal Infant Free School Meals' scheme, school meals for children in reception, year 1 and year 2 remain free. For children in years 3 and above the charge for meals for the half term will be £78.20. It would help the school enormously if you could pay for meals by your online Parentpay account. BEGINNING OF THE YEAR REMINDERS

Please can we take this opportunity to remind parents of the following:

- Please, please take extra care while driving and parking near to the school and ensure that you park safely and do not block or park too close to neighbouring drives or roads. Please do not park on the bend near the school drive. The Shoulder of Mutton have kindly offered parents use of their car park at school drop-off and pick-up times, and parents may also use the parking bays opposite Brig Hall. Please pass this on to whoever picks up your children (grandparents, childminders etc.) thank you.
- If your child will be picked up from school by a person who isn't known to school or who doesn't normally pick them up please let school know in advance by phone (01423 872491) or email (admin@kirkbyoverblow.n-yorks.sch.uk). This is to ensure that all children are sent home safely and is especially important for the younger children in Mars and Saturn classes.
- The cloakroom door will open at 8.50am each morning - please do not bring your child into school before this time (unless they are booked into breakfast club).
- Nuts and nut products are not allowed into school due to severe nut allergies. Please do not include nuts or products containing nuts in packed lunches (including lunches for school trips).
- Snacks – children may bring in fresh or dried fruit or a carton of fruit juice only for morning break. Sweets and other snacks must not be brought into school.
- The only bags permitted in school are book bags and drawstring bags for PE kits. Please do not bring other large bags (Gola bags, rucksacks etc) into school.
- New Department for Education regulations now mean that we cannot authorise absences for holidays in term time, please refrain therefore from booking holidays during the academic year. The new regulations also require schools to monitor attendance more closely so we ask that appointments (such as doctors, dentists, opticians etc.) are made outside of school hours whenever possible.
